

TNT 2012: scientific program online Deadline for the Early bird fee extended until the 6th of July

Madrid (Spain): July 2, 2012

The organizers of the 13th edition of the Trends in Nanotechnology International Conference (<u>TNT 2012</u>), taking place in Madrid (Spain), from the 10th until the 14th of September 2012, announce the tentative <u>program</u>. Currently, the event unveils 41 keynote <u>speakers</u>, plus 65 oral presentations from all over the world covering different fields of Nanotechnology.

The call for posters is still open and will close on the 27th of July. The early bird registration fee is extended until the 6th of July.

TNT 2012 will keep the same structure as in past editions, providing a unique opportunity for broad interaction, but specific sessions are planned:

- Atoms and molecular computing
- Graphene & Nanotubes
- Migh spatial resolution spectroscopies under SPM probe
- Latin America N&N
- Modeling at the nanoscale
- Nanobiotechnology
- Nanomaterials for Energy
- NanoPhotonics/NanoOptics & Plasmonics

So far, 12 exhibitors reserved their booth in order to showcase their products, services and expertise and, find some collaborations among the participants. Usually an average of 300 participants joins TNT International Conference every year.

TNT conference provides an ideal venue for industrial, academic and governmental organizations to share common objectives and drive the commercialisation of nanotechnology discoveries. TNT 2012 will take place in the heart of Madrid capital at Escuela Técnica Superior de Ingenieros Industriales (ETSII Madrid – UPM).
